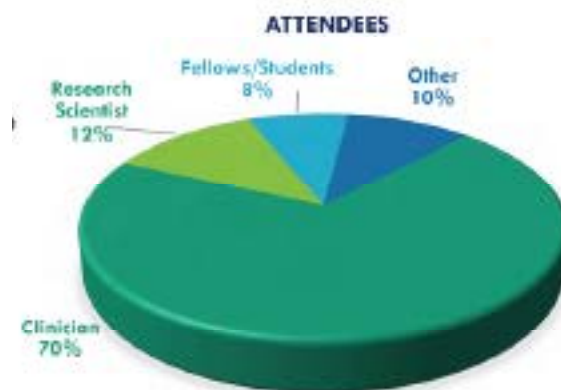
Attendees will:
